The Westpac Rescue Helicopter Service:

- Is owned by our community because over 50% of its operating budget comes from fundraising and donations.
- Conducts over 1,000 medical retrieval and rescue missions per year, many of whom are children.
- Carries highly qualified paramedics from the Ambulance Service of NSW to the scene of accidents and then transports them and the patient/s to hospital for further treatment.
- Many of the accidents involving children are related to horses, quad and dirt bikes and sports injuries.
- Is a vital transport link for those who are critically injured or seriously sick.
