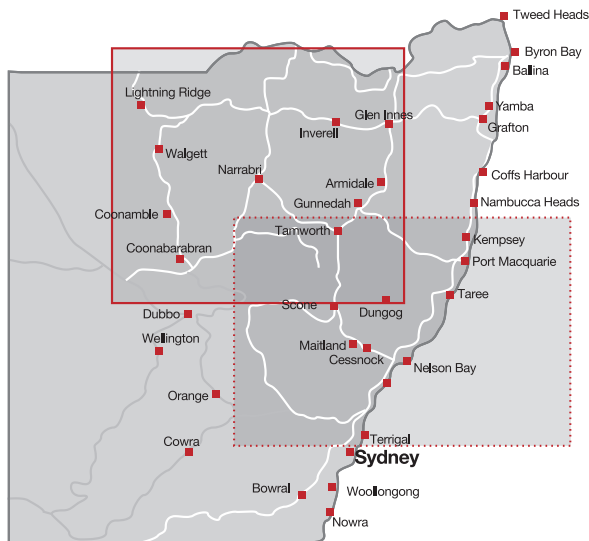


A Vital Service

The Westpac Rescue Helicopter Service was established in the New England - North West region in 2000 and completes over 220 life saving missions per year.

Many of these have been to accidents on farms and properties. Those who have been injured and transported have included people who have been crushed by cattle, thrown from horses, fallen from bikes and injured by farm machinery. A significant number of these have been children who have been injured in quad bike and horse accidents. The Service also transfers patients who are acutely ill from smaller rural based hospitals to specialist care in Tamworth, Newcastle or Sydney. As well as servicing the communities of New England – North West the Westpac Rescue Helicopter Service also works within the communities of the Hunter, Central Coast and Mid North Coast.

How we operate

Our service has a \$3.4 million per year operating budget that comes from our contract with the NSW Health department. The remaining funds are raised through the generosity of the community and our corporate sponsors.

This allows the service to currently operate two BK117 aeromedical rescue helicopters in a one up one down scenario. The service has a fulltime engineer based in Tamworth to carry out maintenance in our purpose built facility. The BK117 has a top speed of 120 knots or approximately 250 kilometres per hour.

The Service has fulltime Pilots and Air Crewman on base that are able to transport emergency paramedics or doctors and nurses depending on the mission.
